

BACHELOR'S/ACCELERATED MASTER'S TRANSITION

- Used by students who have been accepted into an Accelerated Master's program
- Designates how graduate level courses taken, while an undergraduate, will be applied toward the Master's program
- Students must submit to the undergraduate local academic unit by the last day to add classes of their final undergraduate semester.
- Undergraduate local academic units must then submit the form to Graduate Admissions during the student's final undergraduate semester.
 For students scheduled to graduate in Fall, the OGAL should submit the form by October 1st, in Spring by March 1st, and in Summer by July 1st.
- Will not be accepted after graduation from the bachelor's degree program

ADVANCED STANDING:

- Graduate credit taken while an undergraduate student that applies to the bachelor's degree
- Results in an equivalent number of credit hours applied to the pre-designated master's program
- Application of graduate credits will be processed after the student has earned the bachelor's degree and is enrolled in the master's program. Applicable course registration will be verified.
- A minimum grade of "B" is required in each course.
- Grades for Advanced Standing course work do not transfer to the master's only the credits.
