



**DUAL GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM PROPOSAL**  
**(Used to pursue dual master’s programs simultaneously)**

- Students must submit admissions applications to both programs.
- This proposal must be approved by both programs.
- This proposal must be submitted and approved prior to admission to the secondary program.
- Pursuit of dual graduate degrees must be declared by the student within one year of matriculation in the primary program.
- For purposes of administration, students must declare a primary program. If a different rate of tuition is assessed for each program, the student will be assessed at the higher rate, in which case the program with the higher rate should be the primary program.
- Students seeking to develop individualized dual degrees must pay close attention to residency requirements.

Attachments required:

- A written statement explaining: (1) the intellectual or pedagogical purpose behind the degree program; and (2) the academic symmetries that exist between the underlying fields of study.
- A complete program of study must be attached to this form.
